



Water Main Replacement Project

WSH Enterprises, Inc. has completed installation of the waterline at South H Street and 3rd and 4th Streets by Mountain View. Also South G Street between 7th and 9th Street has the water line installed. The Contractor is planning to do the pressure testing for South G Street this week. After a successful pressure test the meter boxes on G Street can be covered and closed this week. The waterline trenches are being closed at the end of each workday. The Contractor is currently working on Western Place. The project is moving along with approved working methods and satisfactory installation of waterline parts.

Bullard Dam NRCS Assessment

We are continuing to work on the Assessment Report.

RETAINER WORK

A portion of every month's retainer billing consists of General Town work of telephone calls, e-mailing, and meetings with Town staff. 

MANAGER'S REPORT
February 2015

I have been spending a lot of time this month working on the Red Rock Biofuels project. We have been having weekly and sometimes biweekly conference call meetings with the Company, State Agency staff, County staff and myself. Besides the various permits and reviews this project is subject to, we have been developing a process for the next steps in the land use and annexation process. The next steps will be the Urban Growth Boundary Adjustment, Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Map Amendment followed finally by annexation. This process will likely take several months.

Amy and I have had a couple of meetings regarding the wood smoke project that will be rolling out later this spring. We expect the program to be ready sometime in May. This project will focus on "sole source" locations, unsafe non-certified locations, other non-certified locations and finally if money allows we would upgrade older certified stoves. The program will also address some basic weatherization needs where practical. There has been some discussion about allowing new pellet stoves to be used on red and yellow days. These appliances have become quite efficient and might offer a good solution for some circumstances. We are also looking to "repair" some existing alternative sources we have learned about. The cost could be much less and they already exist but are in need of service.

I attended the Park and Recreation Master Plan Work Shop at the Courthouse on February 23rd. The session was well attended which was a good indication of the interest in recreational activities in Lake County. The University of Oregon group that is conducting the master planning project also held meetings in Paisley and Christmas Valley.

Other activity for the month included working on the budget for next year. Also preparation for the Greenhouse Well trial, which was tentatively settled before the trial began, required a lot of time. There were SCOEDD and SCOACT meetings in Klamath Falls on February 13th. I continue to meet with our contracted Attorney and Engineer at least weekly and usually more often.

Mayor Mike Patrick called the regular Council Meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Vicky Taylor from Klamath Family Head Start Presented some treats from the kids thanking the council for their patience and work on the project of the new building.

Vicky Taylor thanked the council.

Scott Utley announced that Lakeview had lost Lieutenant Joseph Langdale a survivor of World War II at the age of 100 years old.

Jan Wright questioned the council on the new Ordinance No. 851. Jan is wondering how the public can be fined for wood burning in the certified stoves when the new standards for the stoves will change in one year.

Ms. Wright also questioned the “green dot” program.

Jan commented that in regards to the Red Rock Bio Fuel plant the public have a million questions and they are wondering when a public meeting may commence.

Jan Wright questioned Red Rock biofuels.

Ray Simms discussed the Ordinance No. 851 and that there has not been any fines sent, there has been warning letters mailed but no fines have been issued.

Jan Wright questioned if there has been anyone denied the exemption.

Ray Simms stated there has been one denial of an exemption; the reasoning for this was that it was a commercial structure and in the ordinance it states commercial structures are not eligible for exemptions.

Mike Patrick added that there has been a lot of “rumors” regarding this ordinance and it would be appreciated if anyone has questions please come to Town Hall and we are happy to answer them.

Mike Warren addressed Ms. Wright’s question regarding the “green dot” program he stated that from his knowledge that program applies to larger corporations not the ones in Lake County.

Ray Simms informed Jan Wright that the Town of Lakeview has not been directly involved in the land use process for siting the Red Rock facility. That has been working thought the County. The Town worked with the County to expand the Enterprise Zone to include the company’s preferred location on the south side of Kadrmas Road. That was completed last Summer and allows for property tax exemptions under certain circumstances.

Mrs. Wright questioned if ag land had been zoned to industrial.

Ray Simms stated no not at this time. There are some additional land use related steps that will need to occur to bring the property into the Urban Growth Boundary and then into the Town of Lakeview.

Jan Wright asked when that happens will the public have a "voice". Ray Simms stated the Town of Lakeview hasn't had any "voice" in the land use actions that are currently taking place. There will be opportunity for public comments in the future land use steps that will come.

John Buck questioned the council on how Ordinance No. 851 came about.

Mayor Patrick discussed that there had been 3 public meetings 2 in town and 1 at Westside School; the town council and air quality committee had 10-12 meetings discussing the ordinance.

Ray Simms wanted to clarify in the ordinance when emergency is mentioned it is not referring to an air quality emergency, but for the fact there was so much time spent on discussing the ordinance it was an emergency to get an ordinance in place before the beginning of the air monitoring season, November 1st. Without an emergency declaration in the ordinance, they are not effective for 30 days. With an emergency, they are effective immediately.

Dennis Morrill asked if Ray Simms would discuss how if the Town doesn't come into compliance how it would affect the businesses.

Mr. Simms discussed that if we cannot come into compliance with our wood smoke that when it comes time for companies like Collins Company and Cornerstone to renew their discharge permits with EPA, the EPA will likely require the businesses to install the best available technology and the cost of that equipment may force them to close.

William Neal questioned what if wood stove is a person's only source of heat.

Ray Simms informed Mr. Neal that this year there was an exemption available to homes with sole source heat. Next year the exemption will not be available for the fact there are funds coming available to help the public obtain another source of heat to use on the red and possible yellow days. The Town is not asking anyone to not burn wood, just to not burn wood on yellow or red days, which a few.

Jan Wright questioned where the marijuana discussion stands.

The council informed her that the voters have made it legal in July of 2015 so it is out of their hands.
